- Students will be able to participate in an "Ensemble Workshop" either right before or after his/her recital! This will give students an additional 45 minutes to learn new ensemble skills!
- Students will be scheduled to play in a non-judged recital. Each recital may include students of different playing levels. Recitals will begin in the morning and continue into the afternoon. The ending time depends on the number of students entered and the length of their pieces. Your recital time will be announced two weeks before the event. Please inform your teacher of any special time requests due to conflicting events and note them on the permission slip.
- Groups will most likely be scheduled from 2:00 5:00 PM.
- Students will have to be present during their entire scheduled recital. Family members and teachers are welcome to attend these recitals.
- Students are encouraged to dress appropriately for a performance.

Rules for Performance

- 1. At least one performer must be a current student of an FCMTA teacher.
- 2. All students should arrive 10 15 minutes before their scheduled recital time. Instrumentalists should allow more time if they wish to warm-up.
- 3. **No photocopied music is allowed.** Music produced from CD files or electronically purchased music is acceptable.
- 4. Students may perform up to two pieces as long they do not exceed the following time limits:

Elementary Level: 3 minutes Intermediate Level: 4 minutes Advanced Level: 5 minutes

5. A \$15.00 fee will be charged for each scheduled ensemble. Make checks payable to your teacher.
